Van Buren's Medieval Garden and Bridge

All bricks will be used in our paver walkway around our Medieval Bridge or in our new pathway which leads to our Outdoor Learning Center. Gift certificates are also available!

Over the past several years, Van Buren Schools have constructed a Medieval Garden, a Bridge, and an Outdoor Learning Center as service learning projects. These projects promote giving back to our community while learning through a hands-on approach. All of the projects have been entirely funded through grants, fundraisers, and donations. The grants that have made this project possible are: ECLIPSe, The Findlay-Hancock County Community Foundation, Learn and Serve, COSMOS, Lowes, and the Alternative Opportunity Center's Safe and Drug Free School Grant.

Due to an overwhelming community response in past years, Van Buren Schools would like to offer the community another opportunity to purchase a "Brick." The brick will be 4 x 8 inches. These Bricks will be laser blasted with your name or logo of choice. Your inscription can be up to 3 lines with 14 characters per line. The bricks will then be used as pavers in our Medieval Bridge or Outdoor Learning Center pathway. This current order will be placed in March of 2010 and the pathways will be configured the summer of 2010 by Deeds Outdoor Development.
